#### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

Under the guidance of the Membership Director, Child Watch Providers are responsible for providing safe and nurturing care for the children of members using the service.

## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Treat all children with respect and dignity.
- 2. Assist with general housekeeping duties.
- 3. Attend all staff meetings.
- 4. Report to the Coordinator any concerns with children or parents.
- 5. Care for the children, playing with them and/or providing safe playthings for their amusement.
- 6. Be punctual in the room and ready to start on time.
- 7. Provide the children with a model of acceptable adult behavior through everyday conduct.
- 8. Complete annual youth abuse prevention training and other related trainings
- **9.** Perform other duties as assigned.
