

The Sidney-Shelby County YMCA began through the vision and generosity of local community leaders over 50 years ago. Today, that same philanthropic spirit is what sustains the Y's Mission of putting Christian principles into practice through programs that build healthy spirit, mind, and body for all.

The Y is committed to youth development, and what began as a teen center in downtown Sidney many

years ago, has grown into an organization which serves hundreds of youth and teens each day. The Y's Child Development Center provides care for infants, toddlers, those in pre-school and before and after school care. With three out of four children in the program receiving financial assistance, and the Y providing over \$250,000 in assistance for programs and memberships each year, your partnership is essential.

The Y also serves over 1,000 youth each year in aquatics, kinetics, youth sports leagues, competitive teams and summer camp programs. Many of these families would not be able to afford the program fees without the help of the dollars raised through the Y's Annual Community Partner's Campaign.

While YMCAs are known for their traditional wellness centers and fitness classes, the Sidney-Shelby County Y also provides evidence-based programs to help cancer survivors and those with Parkinson's Disease.
