GUIDING GRACE



Scripture Focus: "Oh, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together." – Psalm 34:3 (ESV)

The word magnify is powerful. When we think of a magnifying glass, we think of bringing small things into

focus — seeing details we might otherwise overlook.

But God is not small. He's already great — infinite in power, love, and wisdom. So why does David invite us in Psalm 34 to magnify Him? Because magnifying God isn't about making Him bigger — it's about bringing Him closer. It's about adjusting our spiritual lens to see His presence more clearly in the ordinary moments, in the small things we might dismiss or miss altogether. In our day-to-day lives, we have a choice: we can move through the motions... or we can take time to magnify God in the midst of it all.

When we magnify God as adults:

- We remember that this work is holy, even when it's messy.
- We recognize His grace in the laughter and His peace in the planning.
- We invite Him to shape our attitudes, our patience, and our example for the kids watching us.

We are invited to look closely — to let Him refine our focus, shift our priorities, and draw us nearer. We may be planting seeds that we'll never see grow — but we can trust that God sees every detail magnified in His perfect view.

Reflection: Where are you struggling to see God clearly right now? What in your life needs to be brought into focus through the lens of faith?

Prayer: Lord, help us to slow down and see You clearly. In the noise, in the stillness, in the work and in the worship — help us magnify You. Use our hands, our hearts, and our words to reflect Your greatness. Let the children see You through us. In Jesus' name, amen.



In March the Y kicked off their annual Community Partners Campaign fundraiser. Your gifts help transforms lives, helping families access childcare, youth sports, wellness programs, and more.
